Contract Update

There was a delay between members approving the contract and the signing of the contract due to issues over retro payments for overloads. It took extra time to work out these details. Calculating and verifying retroactive overload payments is time consuming. UMS will process the raise and retroactive raise on base salary which will show up in the April pay. Retro overload payments will be delayed, potentially to the June payment. The contract itself is getting a badly needed reformatting so an electronic version is not yet available.
